PARIS TOO COSTLY STUDENTS REALIZE

Many From European Countries Forced To Return Home When Funds Give Out.

PARIS, May 13.—Students in the Latin Quarters have been so hard hit by the continual rise in the cost of living that hundreds of young foreigners coming from countries whose exchange is low compared with the franc have been forced to go to Berlin to continue their studies.

Only Americans, English, Spaniards and natives of some of the Scandinavian countries can afford to live in the shadow of the Sorbonne. For the rest—and they are a large majority Roumanians, Greeks, Italians, all manner of Orientals—it is "nach Berlin" or "back home."

There are actually in the various schools which comprise the educational world of the "Quarter" 17,264 French and 3,564 foreign students

regularly inscribed. These are about the same figures as in the year preceding the war for the foreign students and an increase of nearly 3,000 for the French. But the cost of living has more than tripled.
