FORD IS COLLECTING OLD FARM MACHINES

Will Have Museum of Early American Implements at Farm at Dearborn.

(By United Press to The Bend Bulletin.)
DEARBORN, Mich., June 23.—Henry Ford is collecting threshing machines. He returned recently from a three-day automobile trip through southwestern Pennsylvania, in the vicinity of Washington, Pa., where he went in search of an old "bunt" thresher of the vintage of 1820, which he had heard had been discovered in an old foundry. He found the machine and also one of the 1847 period. Both were purchased and sent to Detroit.

Ford is housing his threshing machine collection on his old home farm near Dearborn and intends to make this farm a museum of early American farm implements.
