CHAIN NEW HUBBY TO CONCRETE COP

Stirring Scene Witnessed At The Dalles. By Tourists—Bride Rescues Garage Man.

THE DALLES, July 21.—A man chained and handcuffed to a concrete "traffic cop" on a downtown street corner on a recent evening, revealed to the eastern tourists driving through town that the west is still wild, even as they had learned from the movies. Undoubtedly he was a horse thief or train robber, held there while the lynch party was being organized.

Had they tarried for a few moments, however, the tourists would have seen the apparent executions fall back while a meek looking little woman drove up in a taxi, hopped out and unlocked the prisoner.

It was all a plot on the part of employes of a local garage to punish James B. "Jimmie" Sharp, salesman

at the garage, for getting married. Sharp was overpowered, and handcuffs loaned by a policeman "in" on the plan were snapped on his wrists. Sharp was then chained to the concrete traffic marker and a sign reading "just married" fastened to his back. After two hours of punishment, the key to the handcuffs was sent to the new Mrs. Sharp with the admonition that if she wanted a husband, she had better come and get him.

FINDS ORANGES TIED ON MESQUITE BUSHES

Woman Pays \$12,000 For "Orange Grove." Then Visits Property She Has Purchased.

SANTA ANA, Cal., July 21.—Losing \$12,000 cold cash, and finding oranges tied on mesquite bushes instead of orange groves, is the story

of Mrs. George Ludlow of Medicine Hat, Canada.

Several months ago, while living at Valcarres, Canada, Mrs. Ludlow purchased what was represented to be a 15-acre orange grove in Texas, near Donna on the Mexican border.

About a month ago Mrs. Ludlow started out to look up her \$12,000 worth of land and oranges, but when she got there, she found reasonably fertile land, but no orange trees; nothing but mesquite bushes to whose scraggly branches were tied measly little dried up oranges.

PRESIDENT OF U. P. PLANS EXTENSION

New Work To Be Done In Utah To Aid In Obtaining Tourist Business.

SALT LAKE CITY, July 21.—President Carl R. Gray of the Union Pacific has under consideration a plan to build an extension of the U. P. to Zion national park and Cedar Breaks, the wonderland of Utah.

Utah has long been hampered in obtaining tourist traffic to this wonderfully beautiful but little known section, because of the lack of easy transportation.

While President Gray would not commit himself, he returned from an outing and inspection of this section of southern Utah recently and let it be known that the Union Pacific, which obtained control of the Salt Lake Route recently, is considering a branch line into the district.

J. T. Hardy, traveling freight and passenger agent for the S. P. & S., stated when asked as to the possibility of the branch line up the Deschutes valley suspending operations. "Our locomotives are oil burners," Hardy said, "so the question of coal naturally does not directly concern us."

Deviations from schedule have been almost entirely the result of delays on the main line, Hardy said.

Drawings for Reproductions.

Some artists make drawings many sizes larger than they are to be printed, sometimes seven or eight times as large; others work twice or three times as large. There is no requirement in regard to size, medium or material, just so they will reproduce.
