

# CHINESE CITY BATTLE STAKE

## Warn Americans to Quit Danger Zone

## Anti-foreign Demonstration Reported Continuing—Agitators Active

(U. P. Leased Wire to The Bend Bulletin)  
 WASHINGTON, June 6.—A battle for the city of Canton between Yunnanese and Cantonese troops in China's civil war is momentarily expected, Consul General Jenkins at Canton cabled the state department today.  
 Americans have been warned to leave that part of Canton where fighting is expected and many women and children already have gone to safer points.  
 New anti-foreign demonstrations occurred today at Amoy, China, with a one day strike declared and more than 2,000 persons parading, Consul Webber advised the department.  
 Agitators from Shanghai are arriving at Amoy, Webber said, and an anti-foreign boycott appears probable.

Consul General Jenkins reports that it is understood General Hsu's Cantonese army is within 40 miles of Canton. Yunnanese troops are entrenched in the eastern suburbs and it is expected that contact with the opposing forces will take place within 36 hours.

**Lack Ammunition**  
 The entire civil administration is established in cement works on Honan island, protected by sand bags and other barricades. The Yunnan troops are said to be short of ammunition and artillery and opinion is they will be defeated.

"The administration is issuing a series of proclamations denying that it is communist, but at the same time promises numerous socialistic reforms to laborers and servants.  
 "The Asheville was at Canton on the afternoon of June 5 and the Campaign was expected that night. The critical local situation has prevented any serious anti-British manifestations so far, but the Americans at Canton are apprehensive. The telegraph line to Hongkong is interrupted.

"Consul General Jenkins has warned the leaders of the opposing forces that the United States government expects American lives and property to be protected."
