Juvenile Delinquency In Astoria Attacked

ASTORIA, June 9.—Returning eight secret indictments charging contributing to the delinquency of minor girls, the circuit court grand jury last evening dealt a heavy blow to the problem of juvenile delinquency in Astoria. In addition, a ninth indictment charging another crime was returned.

Today Sheriff Slusher had in custody five of the men named in the indictments, Walter Pierson, auto salesman; Fred Amerman, laborer; Bud Mannix, farm hand; Earl Roberts, taxi driver, and Wayne Ostrom, truck driver. Bond has been fixed at \$500.
