Chinese had stamped as "unequal" banks to reopen.

Chung Sai Yat Pa reported its Hongkong correspondent as cabling that the Chinese banks there had decided to reopen their doors Monday. Further evidence of the breaking down of the strike there was seen by the newspaper in the report that two Chinese ships were preparing to sail tonight from Hongkong for Canton.

WASHINGTON, June 27.—Anti foreign sentiment at Canton continues high and the situation is "extremely tense," American Consul Douglas Jenkins at Canton reported to the state department today.

A new outbreak may occur at any time, Jenkins said, reporting that British authorities claim that Chinese forces have massed in the city behind Shamen, the foreign colony. "As the Chinese forces have some artillery and an airplane, the situation could become grave," the consul reported.

Davies Pleads Guilty, Gets One to 10 Years

CONCORDIA, Kan., June 27.—Charles R. Davies, retired merchant, charged with assault with intent to kill in connection with an attack on his wife by Kansas City gangsters last October, today pleaded guilty in district court here and was sentenced to from one to 10 years in prison.

Davies was arrested following his confession he hired Kansas City gangsters to kill his wife. Mrs. Davies was beaten and robbed in her home October 14, 1924.

Seven of the gangsters are under arrest on charges of assault.

STOCKHOLDERS LOSE SUIT


