

# U. S. SUPPORTING CHINA'S DEMAND

## Policy On Territorial Rights to Prevail

### Proposal Moderate One, to Be Favored, Is Belief—Delegates Resign

WASHINGTON, July 2.—With the United States government actively supporting China's demands for conditional abolition of foreign extra-

territorial rights through a treaty revision conference, acquiescence of other powers which have opposed such a step is only a question of time, according to informed quarters here.

As a bid for friendship of the Chinese people and to counteract the anti Japanese demonstrations, the Tokio government is expected soon to accept the American position. Despite the demands of the British in China for "strong arm" methods by their government, it is pointed out here that Great Britain, for the sake of her far eastern prestige, cannot afford to be isolated as an alleged opponent of Chinese aspirations.

The American policy is a moderate one on which the powers in their own interests can easily unite, it is said.

The United Press can state authoritatively that this government's instructions to Minister MacMurray in Peking favor a conference now to study treaty revision, but oppose granting complete abolition of extra-territoriality in the near future.

President Coolidge and Secretary Kellogg, though deciding upon a change in China's international status, are determined that such change must be very gradual and safeguarded by many conditions which no Peking government can meet in full for several years.

Concrete plans for bringing about an immediate joint conference of the powers in China for conditional abolition of foreign extra-territoriality were completed and set in motion by Secretary of State Kellogg today.

The program, as ascertained exclusively by the United Press, follows:

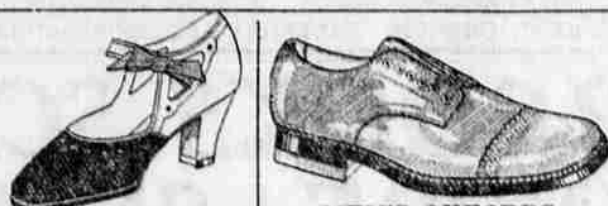
1. An identical memorandum was dispatched today by Kellogg to Minister MacMurray in China and American diplomatic representatives at London, Paris, Tokio and other interested capitals, instructing them to urge the powers to support the American policy.

2. If support of the powers is secured, the American conference proposal will be embodied in the reply of the foreign diplomatic corps in Peking to the unanswered Chinese note demanding abolition of extra-territoriality. China will then issue conference invitations in line with resolution No. 5 of the Washington conference.

3. If the powers decline to send a proposed conciliatory reply to the Chinese note suggesting that China call a conference, then the United States government will formally call a conference which all the other powers cannot easily reject.

adjustment of the Shanghai situation were broken today when the Chinese negotiators, scheduled to meet informally Saturday with foreign diplomats, resigned.

Their resignations resulted from an unwillingness to restrict the proposed discussions solely to the Shanghai episode, they holding that more far reaching and fundamental problems had also been considered by the two parties.

NEW YORK, July 2.—Foreign women and children have fled from the island of Hainan in the province of Kwangtung, China, according to a cable received today by the board of foreign missions of the Presbyterian church here from L. W. Lowrie, head of the China council at Shanghai.

Almost all foreigners have left for Hongkong or elsewhere, the cable added, indicating that the situation still remains critical.

HONGKONG, July 2.—Following attempts to board British vessels, a Chinese mob began an attack upon foreign hotels at Swatow. The landing of an armed party from the British warship Blue Bell served to quiet the mob, which dispersed. Later the naval forces were withdrawn.

Swatow is a treaty port northeast of Hongkong.

The British council member, Holyoak, has published a letter saying that if American members of the Canton college staff still adhere to their views concerning the Shameen shooting—the college staff recently held the foreigners in the colony were responsible—the least they can do is to remove themselves from the colony of the powers, whose action they persist in describing as wanton brutality.

## War Taught Surgeons Much, Says Canadian

PORTLAND, July 2.—Surgeons learned more during the world war than they would have learned in decades if it had not occurred. Sir Henry M. W. Gray of Montreal told the Pacific Northwest Medical association convention, in session here.

He was consulting surgeon for the third British army on the western front. He told how he was operating one day on a British soldier who had a bullet in his heart. He found that by exerting slight pressure at a certain place he could stop its beating and that the soldier, who was not under an anaesthetic, did not know that his heart had stopped.

The soldier lived. His was one in hundreds of strange cases which were experienced by each surgeon in the army hospitals.

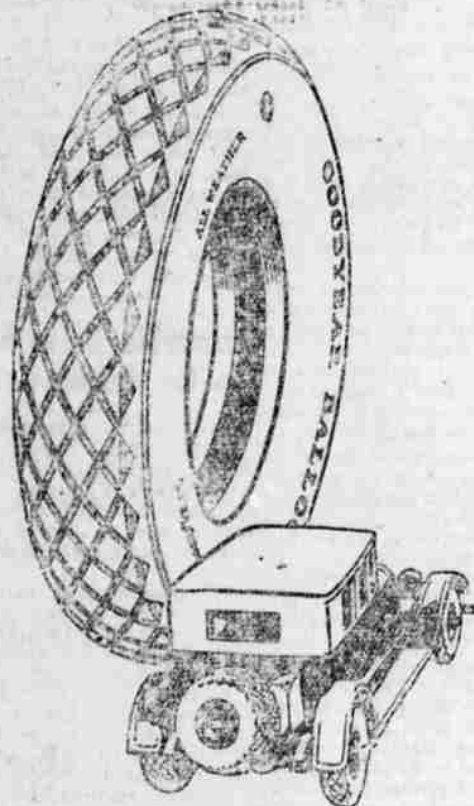

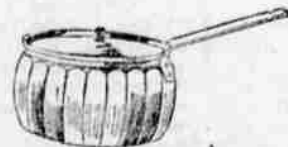
