HOME SITE TRACT TO BE DEVELOPED

Deschutes Park Realty Co.
Is Organized

Announcement of the development of a new home site tract three blocks distant from mill B of the Brooks-Seanlon Lumber Co. and adjoining the pavement of The Dalles-California highway, was made today by the management of the Deschutes Park Realty Co. Don Peoples is president of the new organization.

Work extending the water main from the west end of Roosevelt avenue, near the Deschutes river, to The Dalles-California highway was started this morning. Arrangements have been made by the development company with the Bend Water, Light & Power Co. to lay an eight inch main, connecting with a six inch pipe, down Roosevelt avenue. This pipe line will be 2,700 feet long. The

property is already tapped by an electric light line.

Three hundred lots and 40 one acre tracts are to be placed on the market by the Deschutes Park Realty Co., according to Peoples. These lots and acre tracts will be sold on easy terms, and reliable parties will be furnished lumber to construct homes. Also, loans for the construction of homes will be procured by the management of the company.
