COOLIDGE'S LIFE MENACED, CLAIM

Norman Klien, Alleged
Anarchist, Taken

Secret Service Agents Work
For Months Before Man
Found and Arrested

(U. P. Leased Wire to The Bend Bulletin)
TAMPA, Fla., July 31.—Norman Klien, wanted in Washington and other cities on a charge of having threatened to kill President Coolidge, was arrested here early today by United States secret service agents.

Klien, alias Kully, Alias Kelly, is the alleged leader of a band of anarchists. Government agents said he had threatened the lives of John D. Rockefeller, Henry Ford and Thomas Edison, as well as that of the president.

The arrest followed a chase of many months which led secret service agents through many sections of the country.

Klien has revealed that Tampa is the headquarters of anarchists who have plotted the destruction of noted men.

The prisoner's authorship of certain letters said to have been written to President Coolidge has been reported certain by department of justice official for several months. However, the existence of a band of anarchists in Tampa and the plot to kill Ford and Edison was not suspected until the probe here.

Sargent Renders Opinion
Permitting Sale to Ford

WASHINGTON, July 31.—Attorney General Sargent has rendered an opinion to the shipping board, holding that in advertising 200 ships for sale for junk and arranging to dispose of them on this basis, it is acting legally and within its rights under the merchant marine act.

The ruling opens the way to knocking down the ships to Henry Ford at the next meeting of the board, Tuesday. Ford has bid \$1,700,000 for them.
