### STOCK LEADERS STILL ADVANCE

### Freight Statistics Aiding Rail Quotations

(Wall Street Journal Financial Review)  
 NEW YORK, Aug. 13.—No indication of distribution of stocks was observable today in the behavior of recent leaders such as Mack Truck, American Can and General Electric. These issues continued to advance into record territory, making a powerful impression on the speculative imagination by the ease with which they absorbed profit taking on a rising price scale.

Rails made excellent response to the latest freight traffic statistics, showing car loadings above the 1,000,000 mark for the third consecutive week. Last year it was the end of August before the figure passed a million. Fisher Body and General Motors were well bought in anticipation of important developments after the close. Sharp advances occurred in Westinghouse Air Brake, International Telephone and other specialties.

### Oregon Boards Scan Tumalo District Need

 to plans outlined by Tumalo district officials. The luncheon period will be featured by a program of brief addresses by the visiting officials.  
**Picnic Planned**  
 Arrangements are being made to have members of the Bend Commercial club, including the board of directors, attend the picnic luncheon in Tumalo. Railroad officials will also probably be present. Following the luncheon period, the commission and board members will visit with settlers in the vicinity of Tumalo.  
 The state officials will complete their inspection of the Tumalo district in one day, on August 19 Wednesday, and will probably leave Bend the following morning for the Ochoco project in the Prineville country. Before returning to Salem, the commission and board members will also visit the Summer lake project in South Central Oregon.  
 Duties of the irrigation and drainage securities commission are to examine and report on irrigation and drainage districts requesting certification of bonds in order that the bonds may become legal investments for all trust funds, and to exercise certain supervision over the affairs of irrigation districts. The superintendent of banks, state engineer and attorney general constitute the commission, which is authorized to enter into contracts with irrigation and drainage districts for the payment of interest by the state on bonds for any one or more of the first five years.

### July First Set

It is the duty of the desert land board to make application to the secretary of the interior for the segregation of lands to be reclaimed, enter into contracts with the federal government for their reclamation and enter into contracts with construction companies for the construction of the necessary works and the colonization of the project. Members of the board are the governor, the secretary of state, state treasurer, attorney general and the state engineer.
