

# DANGERS SEEN IN PROPAGANDA

## Irrigation Attacked by Work, Says Sinnott

### News Story from Washington Impugns Motives of Oregon Lawmakers

News dispatches from Washington relative to the action taken by the Pomona grange of Wallowa county in condemning the policy of Senator Charles L. McNary and Congressman N. J. Sinnott in working for the further reclamation of Oregon lands through irrigation were bitterly commented on by Sinnott, who left today for The Dalles after spending several days in Bend.

While in Bend for the past few days Congressman Sinnott frequently referred to the Washington dispatches, and stated his opinion that the office of the secretary of interior had been "prostituted to the circulation of propaganda" designed to discredit Senator McNary and himself. A considerable part of Sinnott's address at the North Unit banquet in Madras Wednesday night was given to the criticism of Dr. Hubert Work of the reclamation bureau.

"I must be frank with you and tell you that irrigation has fallen on evil days," Congressman Sinnott said in preface to his criticism of Work at the Madras banquet. "I read in today's Oregonian a Washington, D. C. dispatch, obviously given out

from the secretary of interior's office, stating that the attitude of Senator McNary and myself on irrigation has been condemned in a communication addressed to the secretary of interior. It is passing strange that the great office of the secretary of interior is the vehicle to broadcast propaganda against reclamation."

After saying that it is amazing that the office of the secretary of interior is used to discredit and impugn the motives and activities of Oregon's representatives in congress, Sinnott continued: "Every piece of reclamation legislation advocated by the secretary of interior, and enacted into law, was secured by the cooperation of Senator McNary and myself. Indeed, the secretary has personally thanked and commended both of us for our cooperation in securing the legislation he desired. But when we demand justice in Oregon, his great office is prostituted to the circulation of propaganda designed to discredit and hamstring us."

"I am loath on account of our friendly relation to believe that the secretary of interior himself is guilty of this sniping from Washington at those working for your interests," Congressman Sinnott said in conclusion of his statement, which contained a resume of the work of McNary and himself in securing needed legislation for this state. "But from whatever source it comes, you may rest assured of our continuous support until Oregon has received at least her just share of the reclamation funds."
