

STOCKS RESUME UPWARD TREND

U. S. Steel Gains Heavily In Trading

(Wall Street Journal Financial Review)
 NEW YORK, Aug. 21.—Stocks resumed the main upward movement in impressive fashion today with the recent irregularities resulting from profit taking erased by the development of an urging demand in many sections of the list.
 Steel common staged its most impressive exhibition in the side of rising prices since the run up to 129 1/2 at the climax of last winter's excited speculation.
 General Electric and American Can surged to the highest levels of their history.
 In the case of the rails the trading was less feverish but substantial advances occurred in many representative issues.

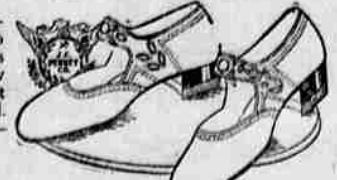
