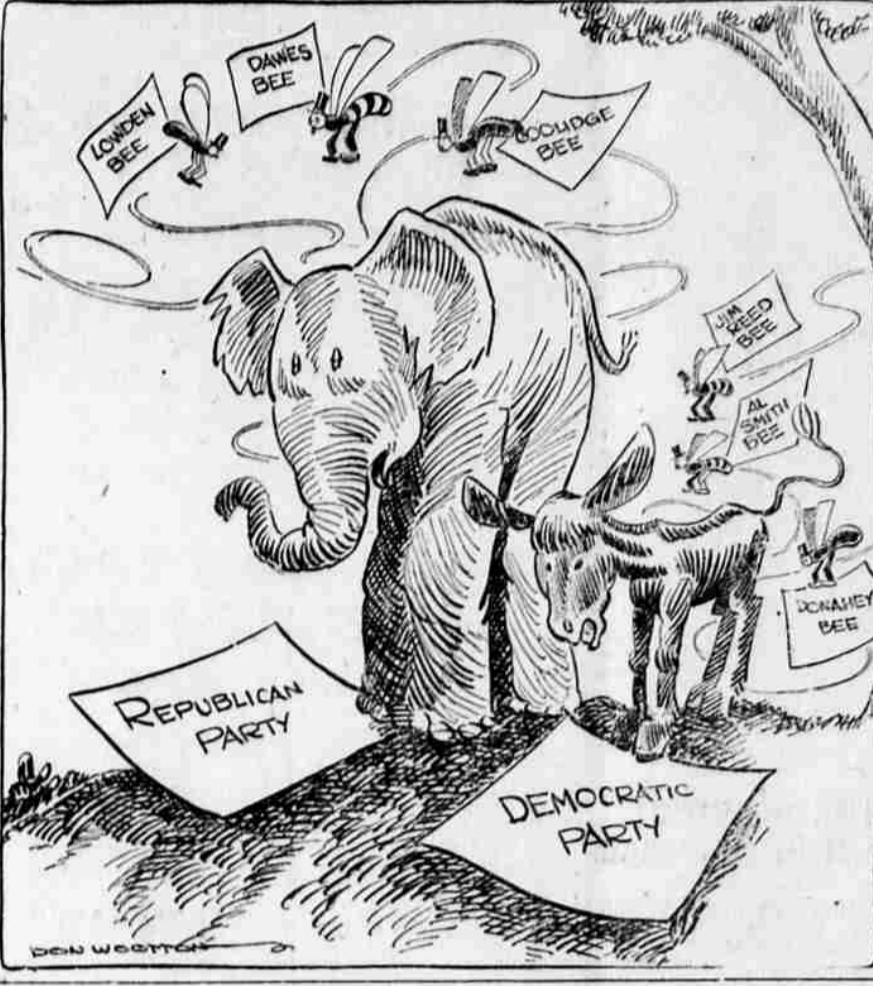

**GOVERNOR WANTS OIL ON HIGHWAYS**  
**Hartley Makes Charges Against "Trust"**  
 Olympia, Wash., July 21.—(AP) —Gov. Roland H. Hartley charged today that a "cement trust" has blocked the oiling of dusty state highways in the past and succeeded in preventing adoption of a comprehensive oiling program submitted to the Legislature in his budget.  
 Hurling these charges in an open letter addressed to Gen. C. B. Blethen, Seattle publisher, the governor said:  
 "There is only one reason why the state of Washington today has neither oiled highways nor any comprehensive oiling program under way, and that is because the cement companies and the sand and gravel concerns, who for years have controlled the state highway department and dictated and directed the road program, do not want oiled highways."  
 He further declared that "with the highway department hermetically sealed up with concrete, these interests have wanted public sentiment aroused over road conditions."  
 The letter was relative to an article appearing in the Seattle Times July 18, in which dusty roads was the topic under the heading "Dusty Roads Driving Tourists Away."  
 The governor admitted that tourists, automobiles, "a golden harvest," is being kept out of Seattle and adds:  
 "More than this, the people of eastern Washington, who through their pioneer struggles on the arid and semi-arid areas, have added millions to the taxable wealth of the state, are being denied the comfort, convenience and economy of travel, either for pleasure or business, to which

they are justly entitled."
