California is a 2 1/2 to 1 favorite over victoryless Washington at Seattle. Santa Clara is 2 1/2 to 1 over Arkansas in a San Francisco game expected to produce the wildest forward passing of the year...

Detroit—The point-after-touchdown, one of the most controversial subjects in college football, will be eliminated from a game between the University of Detroit and Santa

Clara at Sacramento, Cal., Nov. 27. Coach Gus Dorais of Detroit said today.

Frono, Utah—The University of Portland football team was due here today for a battle with Brigham Young university Saturday. Railbirds admitted the odds were fairly even on the contest. Coach Matty Matthews of Portland was said to rank the Utahns as toughest on his schedule, next to St. Mary's.
