Self Starting Wipers Assure Clean Goggles

Clinton, N. Y. (UP)—Goggles with windshield wipers haven't arrived yet, but Dr. G. Harvey Cameron of the Hamilton college physics department, and Dr. Karl Gruppe, Utica otolaryngologist, have perfected something close to it.

Seeking to save time for bronchoscopes probing stomachs for swallowed articles, Cameron and Gruppe invented a self-cleaning pair of goggles for the surgeon's use. The principal feature is the use of a clean, uncoated length of film mounted on two rollers and so affixed that it will glide over the goggles. The receiving roller is supplied with a winding and ratchet mechanism actuated by vertical movements with a crossarm, which in turn is motivated by the opening and closing of the bronchoscopes' jaw.

All the bronchoscopist has to do is move his jaw downward and a clean portion of film slips across his goggles. The roll contains four feet of 122 centimeter film—enough for a normal examination.
