Herbert Francis spoke in behalf of the national wildlife federation and touched on the purposes of the week now being observed throughout the United States.

Scharf Speaks
John Scharf, superintendent of the Malheur wildlife refuge, was the guest speaker, with conservation as his topic. The Malheur refuge, probably the most important of its kind on the continent, now holds 160,000 acres, Scharf said. A total of 214 species of birds are represented at the refuge, and 122 of these are nesting species. Banding and other studies carried on at the refuge were mentioned by Scharf in answering questions.

One topic which proved controversial as the sportsmen took sides was that dealing with open season on does. Members of a Harney county delegation were critical of the Murders creek doe season and charged that over population studies had been deliberately faked.
