New York, Feb. 21 (UP)—Stocks moved irregularly in dull trading in the pre-holiday session today.

Strength in chemical and aircraft shares and weakness in Public Service of New Jersey featured. A few special issues were up or down as much as 2 points, but most net changes were small.

Trading was restricted by caution instilled by war uncertainties.

Steel shares slipped off. U. S. Steel preferred lost 1/4 points to a new low at 17 1/2.

Chrysler met profit-taking and eased, while General Motors was firm. Rubber shares were little changed. Rails were down small amounts with notable exceptions such as Southern Pacific and Pennsylvania. Air lines shares firmed while aircrafts were strong under lead of Douglas, which gained a point.

J. I. Case preferred sold off 5 and DuPont up 2.

Gains of a point and more were noted in Allied Chemical, American Telephone, Eastman, Owens Illinois Glass, Union Tank Car and West Virginia Pulp and Paper.
