

Chrysler Stock Features Market

New York, Feb. 21 (AP)—Chrysler corporation featured the short session on the stock market today by rising to a new high for the year at 60 1/2 up 1 1/2. The issue has been strong since the directors cut the dividend earlier this week to conserve capital for war work.

Enough bulls advanced to send that average up slightly. Utilities were firmer on outlook for possible suspension of the death sentence on holding companies. Oils sagged with many at new lows and chemicals failed to rally after recent declines. Coppers were steady to easier, building issues firm and farm equipments lower. J. I. Case made a new low.

Allied made a new low at 130 1/2, and DuPont preferred made a new low at 121 while Union Carbide equaled its low. Dow Chemical lost a fraction. Eastman Kodak gained a point.

New lows for the year were made by Phillips, Standard Oil (N. J.) and Texas company. U. S. Rubber preferred made a new low at 60.

A new low for the year was made by Beech-Nut Packing at 81, off 3 1/2 points.

People in The News...

Senator George W. Norris, Ind., Neb., said today the United States may be forced to defend Ireland against German invasion even against Ireland's will.

Senator Guy M. Gillette, D., Ia., says it was not only a "possibility," but a probability, that the Vichy government was allowing the use of Dakar as a refueling base for German submarines.

At an educational convention at San Francisco, Dr. John W. Studebaker, U. S. commissioner of education, appealed for sweeping changes which would step up graduation of urgently needed specialists, which include engineers, chemists, doctors, and pharmacists.

Gov. Culbert Olson warned that his state of California may need to prepare against possible bombing raids or attempted invasion of her coastline. He said California was definitely in the theater of the Pacific war.

Navy officials said today that Joseph F. McDonald of Reno, Nev., who was believed killed by the Japanese at Wake Island, may be a Japanese prisoner. The navy said there were two Joseph McDonalds on Wake Island and it was believed they had been confused.

At Stockton, Cal., Giovanni Sanguinetti, 62-year-old Italian ranch worker who invested his life savings of \$4500 in defense bonds, became despondent because he was classed as an enemy alien and hanged himself.

Portland U. Downs Gonzaga

Portland, Feb. 21 (AP)—University of Portland scored a 39-30 win over Gonzaga in a basketball game here last night after leading most of the way.

Gonzaga was active in the early part of the first half, but Portland pushed ahead to a 17-15 half time score. In the second half the score was tied once, but the danger was only temporary.
