FOR A FENCE IN THE PARK
Early this month Mrs. Ruth Repnock, contributing to the discussion regarding dogs and gardens, raised the worthwhile point that filth from the river water fowl made the grassy areas in Drake park virtually unusable for picnic and other parties in the summer season.
