

Eastern Mart Suffers Slump

New York, June 21 (AP)—Stocks slipped lower in one of the slowest sessions of the year today as traders awaited the outcome of the nation's third coal mine shutdown in the past seven weeks.

There was little selling and prices were off principally because of the lack of buying interest, closing with losses running to around a point.

Steel and motor leaders generally held slightly below their previous closing levels but a number of war equipment stocks were weak.

The American Iron & Steel Institute reported today that the nation's steel mills are scheduled to operate this week at 97.6 per cent of capacity compared with 77.8 per cent last week.

Nevertheless, little selling came into the steel shares, apparently because of the Wall Street adage against selling on strike news.

ST. Helens Man Named Pastor
Portland, June 21 (AP)—Wartime travel restrictions and service as chaplains in the armed forces today were seen as factors in the small number of pastoral changes in Oregon Methodist churches—fewest in more than 20 years—announced by Bishop Bruce Baxter.

Prominent among the shifts was the exchange of pulpits between Rev. L. O. Griffith of McMinnville and Dr. B. Earl Parker of Eugene.

Rev. Robert McIlvanna of St. Helens was transferred to Bend, but will also have supervision over Methodist members in Redmond. Bend's former pastor, Rev. John B. Coan, was appointed to Kennewick, Wash.

Rev. Herbert Kuehn will fill the vacancy at St. Helens. He had been a student worker on the University of Oregon campus and was attached to the First Methodist church, Eugene.

Pool Dredging Is Completed
Dredging of the swimming pool in the Deschutes river at Harmon playfield has been completed and The Shelvin-Hilxon Company's dredge was removed from the river yesterday and taken back to the mill pond, where it is used to maintain channels for logs.

It was brought to Harmon playfield two weeks ago and dredging work has been in progress in evenings since that time. A maximum depth of seven feet was dredged in the large pool enclosed by beams formerly used in water pageants on Mirror pond.

Construction of a frame dressing room structure on the field is also planned.
