The navy representative emphasizes that men of draft age cannot enlist in the navy, but he points entist in the navy but he points out that the navy has two programs for which these men can volunteer, through their draft boards, if they are technicaly and physically qualified and are not in a deferred status by virtue of being eneaged in essential work.

One such program is the radio chance to enter the navy at the advanced rating of seaman, first class, and to learn the science of electronics and its use in radar. This is a ten-month course, the equivalent of two years of college.
