Records going back to 1867 showed that the total of sheep and lambs now is at the lowest point since 1880. The number of sheep and lambs on Oregon farms Jan. 1, 1944, is estimated at 1,217,000 head, which was 16 per cent fewer than the number a year earlier, and 41 per cent below the 1935-1939 average.


