\*\*Madras, March 1 (Special)—A soils and crops conference was held at the office of County Agent Kenneth W. Sawyer last Tuesday. A group of reclamation bureau officials from Boise and Salem attended. The group met to outline basic recommendations on soils and fertilizer, water application and getting your home canning sugar, starting May 15. Ask your local war price and rationing board to mail you an application (OPA Form R-341) or stop in at the board and pick it up in person. Fill out the form and attach to it a "Spare Stamp 13" from war ration book four for each member of the family covered in the application. Mail it, or take it in person, to the board.

They will decide, on the basis of the application, how much sugar you're permitted, and then will issue coupons good for five pounds or one pound each. The coupons will be good through November 30, 1945, but applica

Reiter said that the order has been in for two years, and that he was advised by the Portland laboratory that it is doubtful whether it can be filled owing to a shortage of help.

These parasite infested earwigs, if obtained, will be released in the city. The parasite eats the earwig to which it has been attached by hand, then spreads to other earwigs and causes their ultimate deaths.
