

Decline Affects Stock Recovery

By Elmer C. Walzer (United Press Financial Editor) New York, March 5 (UP)—A minor decline soon overcame by a broad recovery represented by Wall street's first reaction to a stiffening in margin requirements on the leading exchanges.

About the only indication of some pressure to eliminate short-selling market operators was a falling off in volume. Stocks opened irregularly higher and then turned down in the leading groups for a brief period.

The stock exchange and curb exchange announced stiffer margin regulations after the close Saturday. These involved elimination of margins on stocks selling under \$10 a share and an equity in accounts of at least \$1,000, plus a rise in margins generally from 23 per cent to 25 per cent of market value.
