Tim Sullivan, a sheepman residing east of Bend, today obtained his liberty on \$50 bond after being arrested on a warrant charging cruelty to animals. He was taken into custody in a Bond street resort by Officer Lynn Bartholomew.

According to the complaint issued by Municipal Judge H. C. Ellis, Sullivan allegedly tied a horse standing in a truck rack on Irving Avenue "for a period of at least 18 hours throughout a cold, windy, rainy and snowy night, without any shelter whatsoever."
