

Session on Mart Reported Quiet

New York, May 2 (UP)—Stocks moved irregularly through a relatively quiet session today.

A sufficient number of leaders showed declines to bring losses into the averages. But there were many gainers, and some of them sizeable. Traders displayed a bit more caution in making new commitments pending definite word on the end of the war in Europe which the unconditional surrender of German forces in Italy seemed to bring nearer.

President Truman recommended a \$7,000,000,000 (B) cut in funds for shipbuilding. That brought declines into the steel shares ranging to 1 1/4 points in Bethlehem and smaller losses in some of the shipbuilding companies. Bethlehem, one of the biggest shipbuilding units, recovered part of its loss.

Rails were displaying a better tone near closing. They furnished the bulk of the trading. Lehigh Valley, Chicago Great West, Erie, New York Central, and Baltimore & Ohio were active. The first two made new highs. Nickel plate preferred gained a point. Pere Marquette preferred lost 2 points.

Food for Dutch Drops From Sky

London, May 2 (UP)—The U. S. Eighth air force planes returned to Holland for the second time within 24 hours today to drop more loads of food to the starving Dutch.

Today's loads brought to approximately 1,500 tons the total dropped since the mercy operations were started yesterday.

About 400 Flying Fortresses dropped approximately 800 tons of food again today.

One Fortress crew reported they had been fired upon by small arms despite the German "no fire" agreement, but that was the only such incident reported.
