

Irregular Drop Noted on Market

New York, May 9 (AP)—Stocks made an irregular decline today on contracted volume.

Special issues attracted a substantial following but the main list was neglected and a sufficient number of rails and industrials needed to bring declines in those averages. Small gains predominated in the main group of utilities.

Market operators moved cautiously because of the uncertainties over partial reconversion of industry. Big corporations said they had no idea that the government had in mind regarding the changeover and they were maintaining a crossed-fingers attitude. As a result the trading element in stocks tended to sell the so-called war issues and buy selected issues in the peace groups.

Utilities, building shares, some of the rail equipments and steamship lines were active. In the latter group American export lines made a new high on a rise of more than 2 points and U. S. lines rose nearly a point. Coppers made new highs and then backed away on profit-taking.
