

Leading Stocks Register Losses

By Elmer C. Walzer (United Press Financial Editor) New York, May 21 (UP)—Stocks moved irregularly today on curbed volume. Some of the leading issues registered losses running to more than a point following a modest rally in the general market last week.

Activity centered on a few isolated issues in the leading groups. National Power and Columbia Gas led utilities and each made a new high; American and Foreign power second preferred also had a sizeable volume and made a high on a rise of more than a point.

Allegheny corporation preferred at 49 1/2 up 1/4; Baltimore and Ohio at its high of 19 1/2 up 1/4 and New York Central at 3/4 up 1/2 were active in the rails. Hudson featured the motors in turnover and lost more than a point on week-end denial by the Fisher Brothers they were buying control of the company. Consolidated-Vultee-made a new high and led the aircrafts in turnover.
