

Margin Rumors Affect Market

Walzer (United Press Financial Editor) New York, May 31 (AP)—Following recent custom after a few days of market rise Washington today circulated rumors that stricter margin controls were in the offing. Simultaneously stocks receded on reduced volume. Wall Street experts were unwilling to concede that the recession coming on top of the margin rumors was anything but a coincidence. They held that the list was entitled to a technical correction at this stage of the rise. Losses generally are small and partly recouped before the close. Recently strong railroad shares had declines of as much as 2 1/4 points in Santa Fe at the lows. The latter came back part way. Several strong spots developed among the high-priced rails. New York and Harlem ran up 4 points and Norfolk and Western 2 points.
