

Prices Lowered On Stock Market

My Elmer C. Walker (United Press Financial Editor) New York, Nov. 21 (UP)—Profiting from reduced prices 1 to more than 3 points on the stock exchange today. Trading increased. Walkout of General Motors employees brought some selling into the stock which at its low was off 1 1/2 points. Chrysler touched 127 1/2 off 2 1/2 and then met meager support. Steel issues had losses running to nearly 2 points. Rails were off 1 to nearly 3 points in the common stocks while the preferreds were off as much as 2 1/2 points in the standard gas group. Bendix aviation broke more than 4 points when directors cut the dividend by 25 cents. Twentieth Century Fox film made a new high on an extra dividend and then retreated to a net loss.

Al (Bummy) Davis Is Holdup Victim New York, Nov. 21 (UP)—Al (Bummy) Davis, 26, New York welterweight prize fighter, was shot and killed early today in a fight with bandits who held up a Brooklyn bar and grill. Police said the four bandits escaped after the shooting. They were reported to have held up seven taverns between 1:30 and 4:30 a.m. Davis, whose real name as Al Davidoff, attempted to stop the men as they left the tavern to get into their car, police said. He was shot in the chest and died before he could be given medical aid. Police said Davis was mowed down by a fusillade of shots when he punched one of the bandits on the jaw. Davis apparently was one of the customers in the tavern.
