

Late Selling Grips Market

By T. W. Klenen (United Press Financial Writer) New York, Nov. 21 (AP) — Dis-

closure by the justice department that "something will be done at the court this afternoon" in the coal mine walkout brought a flurry of late selling into the stock market and forced the tape at one time 3 minutes behind actual floor transactions.

Losses ranged to more than 2 points throughout the leaders with steel shares hard hit in the closing burst of selling. Losses in this group ranged to 2 1/2 points in Bethlehem, Crucible Steel, on which directors today omitted a dividend, led 3 points at its low.

Chrysler dropped more than 3 points to lead the late break in the motors where General was down more than a point.

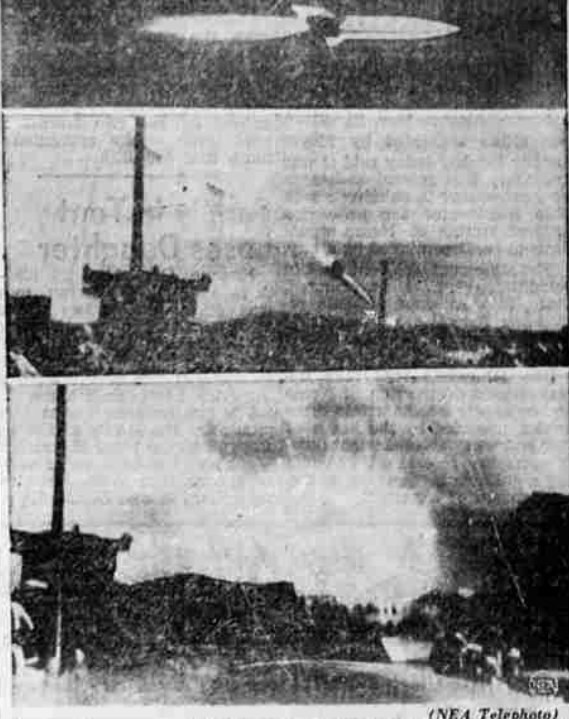

Defective V-2 Controlled Back to Earth



Army Ordnance experts testing German V-2 rockets at White Sands Proving Grounds, New Mexico, recently encountered a defective projectile, which went wrong. Personnel controlling the rocket managed, with instruments, to turn the rocket about five miles up, controlling its course so that it landed, exploding four miles from original launching site. Top photo shows rocket as it was turned from upward flight; middle photo shows it just before it hit and explosion is seen in lower photo. During same tests, one of the V-2 rockets set a world's altitude record of 104 miles. Instruments carried in its nose came down intact and are expected to provide more information than ever before obtained on cosmic ray, temperatures and pressures at that distance from the earth.
