

Armour Stocks Lead On Market

By Elmer C. Walzer (United Press Financial Editor) New York, Jan. 21 (AP)—Armour and company common stocks featured an irregularly lower stock market today both in strength and in turnover.

The meat packing company issue gained a point as the main list lost fractions to more than a point. Armour on Jan. 7 issued its report for its fiscal year ended last Nov. 2 which showed a record net income after setting aside \$9,500,000 for inventory losses.

Armour's rise stood out in its own group. Wilson & Co., which yesterday reported one of the best years in its history in the fiscal year ended last Oct. 26, showed a fractional gain. The company reported net income equal to \$3.43 a share, against \$1.64 a share in the previous fiscal year.
