3 Fliers Found Adrift In Ocean

Honolulu, Feb. 21 (AP)—Three men whose navy plane was forced down 50 miles northeast of Midway island were rescued by the refrigerator ship Alstead yesterday while they were clinging to the wreckage of their slowly sinking aircraft, the navy reported today.

The rescued men were identified as Capt. R. W. D. Wood, commander of the naval operating base and air station at Midway; Lt. (j.g.) J. W. Chapman; and aviation machinist mate H. W. Williams. Their home town addresses were not immediately available.

The navy ordered a search Wednesday when Wood's amphibious scout-observer plane was reported overdue on a flight from Midway. Twenty planes were alerted for the search and the reefer ship, en route from San Francisco to Hawaii, was diverted to join the hunt.
