Stocks Go Down; Trend Irregular

By Elmer C. Walzer (United Press Financial Editor) New York, Oct. 21 (UP)—Stocks turned irregularly lower today and volume lightened. The reaction was seen as a technical one, reflecting caution as the market had approached the July highs, levels which have been regarded as critical for the list.

Bethlehem Steel held a point while U. S. Steel held steady. Chrysler made a new high and then fell back to a decline of nearly a point. General Motors dipped a small fraction. A 3-point loss in Union Pacific and one of more than a point in Santa Fe pulled the rail average down.

More Mental Clinics Urged for U.S. St. Louis (UP)—Five times the existing number of mental health clinics are needed in the United States, according to Dr. James V. Lowery of the U. S. Public Health Service.

Dr. Lowery, senior surgeon of the service's mental hygiene division, says more psychiatric specialists and psychiatric training in general medical courses are required.

He predicts that expanded community mental health programs will result in general improvement in the mental treatment field during 1948.

Dr. Lowery points out, however, that some states still have no mental health programs and that large areas in others do not have access to mental clinic facilities.

Field Yields Corn Crop 76th Straight Year Falls City, Neb. (UP)—Exponents of crop rotation to the contrary, Lloyd and Paul Bachman planted a 24-acre field of corn for what they believe was the 76th consecutive year.

Ordinarily, good farming practice is to change from corn after two or three crops. But the Bachmans have a natural fertilizing system which costs them no money or effort.

This year, the 24-acre field dropped down to an estimated yield of about 60 bushels to the acre.

The land is second bottom on the Missouri river. It is above normal flood stage, but catches the silt which comes down from the hills.

Tip: Lonely Love Birds Don't Make Good Pets Milwaukee (UP)—A Humano society official advised an unknown thief that one love bird is not going to thrive in his home.

The love bird was filched from the society's shelter. Its mate has become morose and Gustave P. Utke warned the thief that the one stolen will refuse to keep on living unless he has a mate.

Utke also expressed bewilderment over the disappearance of nine waltzing mice from the shelter.
