Market Irregular, Action Moderate

New York, Jan. 21 (UP)—The stock market turned irregular to in moderately active trading. Irregularity reflected the reluctance of investors or the Wall Street professionals to trade in any volume pending a start of congress on the new administration's legislative program. Some attention was attracted by the remarks of Irving S. Olds, board chairman of U.S. Steel Corp., who said last night that steel industry should be on guard against attempts at nationalization. A favorable item was provided by a Washington tax expert who told the American management association here today that he foresaw no excess profits tax in either 1949 or 1950, nor any increase in corporate tax rates beyond 45 per cent.
