New York, Feb. 21 (AP)—Trading on the stock market today fell off to the lightest level since last Oct. 11.

Other markets were equally slow as traders remained away from the street for an extended holiday through Washington's birthday.

Bond dealings were light and prices along with stocks declined. Commodities firmed slightly.

Stocks opened steady with a majority of issues either unchanged or within 18 points of their previous closing levels. Thereafter the list drifted lower.

Radio-Ketth-Orpheum developed some activity on approval by its directors of a reorganization plan to conform with the government's anti-trust action. Du Pont firmed slightly in response to a rise of 50 cents in its interim dividend.
