## Phantom Sniper Strikes Again

Philadelphia, Dec. 21 (UP)—Weary police today intensified an all-out search for the phantom sniper after a youth was felled on a darkened street by another mystery bullet last night.

As fear struck still another neighborhood only four days before Christmas, detectives began a door-to-door patrol for the ambush assailant of 16-year-old George Haller, a high school junior.

Haller was hit in the left shoulder by a small caliber slug, trademark of the elusive sniper, while walking home five miles from the house where a young mother was shot to death by an unknown gunman Saturday night.

**One Dead, Eight Hurt**  
 The boy was the latest victim in the frightening toll of mysterious shootings which now include one dead, eight wounded and seven persons shot at in the past three months. He was not seriously hurt.

"For the present we are marking it down as shot by an unknown person," said Detective Allen Kleppinger, one of a corps of investigators pressing the search in the Juniata park area where the boy was shot.

The youth told investigators he heard no shot or saw no gunman when he suddenly felt a "tug" at his shoulder and found blood streaming from a wound.

## Herbert Hoover

## Course Suggested

Hoover suggested the course for the U. S. and its free world partners to follow in a speech broadcast over the radio and television facilities of the Mutual Broadcasting system and rebroadcast later in many cities by the National Broadcasting company.

He said that any involvement of the non-communist nations in a war with the whole communist "land mass" would be "sheer folly . . . and would end in the exhaustion of this Gibraltar of western civilization."

Mr. Hoover echoed the sentiments expressed in a similar policy statement two months ago when he said western Europe should not receive another penny or another soldier from the U. S. for rearmament until the non-communist nations there show the will and ability to resist aggression.

"Otherwise we shall be inviting another Korea," Mr. Hoover said. "That would be a calamity to Europe as well as to us."

The republican elder statesman said the communist world probably has more than 300 combat divisions, 30,000 tanks, 10,000 tactical planes and "further large reserves."

## Red Navy Weak

The reds, however, are weak in naval power and long-range air power, Mr. Hoover said, and on these points the United States can capitalize to ensure its security.

"We Americans alone with sea and air power can so control the Atlantic and Pacific oceans," he said, "that there can be no possible invasion of the western hemisphere by communist armies."

They can no more reach Washington than we can reach Moscow.

Mr. Hoover bluntly declared that "even were western Europe armed far beyond any contemplated program, we could never reach Moscow. The Germans failed with a magnificent army of 240 combat divisions . . ."

And he warned — without amplification — that "we must realize the fact that the atomic bomb is a far less dominant weapon than it was once thought to be."

In his military review, Mr. Hoover wrote off Korea.

"It is obvious," he said, "that the United Nations have been defeated in Korea by the aggression of communist China. There are no adequate forces in the world to repel them."

"Even if we sacrifice more American boys to hold a bridgehead, we know we shall not succeed at the present time in
