Clinic Planned By Coordinator

Miss Verma Stocks, traveling clinic coordinator for Oregon Psychiatric Services for children, is in Bend today, doing preparatory work for the child guidance clinic to be held next Monday and Tuesday in the offices of the Tri-County Health Unit, in the courthouse.

Health department staff members are assisting Miss Stocks with the case work. Children with adjustment problems have been selected for special help at the clinic by teachers, public health nurses and social workers.

The psychiatric services organization which Miss Stocks represents operates under supervision of the University of Oregon Medical School.
