Twelve of the fellowships are in chemistry, four in chemical engineering, and three in physics.

They are offered to 18 U. S. educational institutions which will select a research student in the last year of study for his doctorate.

The basis of selection is the stu the basis of selection is the stu-dent's demonstrated ability in his major field of study, a high de-gree of technical promise, sound-ness of character and personal traits, and financial need.

STANFORD, Calif. UP -A small gland located above the kidneys may be an important factor in heart failure. Stanford University scientists believe this gland, called the adrenal cortex, may play a significant role in retaining excessive amounts of sait in heart disease victims. If research they are now undertaking proves this to be true, the scientists will then investigate ways of modifying its activity.

The research will be directed by Dr. John A. Luetscher, Jr., associate professor of medicine, under grants totalling \$17,000.

Patients suffering from kidney disease with edema (swelling of tissues due to accumulation of fluid) also retain abnormal quan-

ities of sait.

In related studies by Lr. Luetscher, some of these kidney patients have shown great improvement after treatment with the hormones cortisone and ACTH which modified the sait-retaining activity. Similar results may be possible with heart disease, Dr. Luetscher belleves.
