Gland Thought

To Affect Heart
STANFORD, Calif. (AP)—A small gland located above the kidneys may be an important factor in heart failure.
Stanford University scientists believe this gland, called the adrenal cortex, may play a significant role in retaining excessive amounts of salt in heart disease victims. If research they are now undertaking proves this to be true, the scientists will then investigate ways of modifying its activity.
The research will be directed by Dr. John A. Luetscher, Jr., associate professor of medicine, under grants totaling \$17,000.
Patients suffering from kidney disease with edema (swelling of tissues due to accumulation of fluid) also retain abnormal quantities of salt.
In related studies by Dr. Luetscher, some of these kidney patients have shown great improvement after treatment with the hormones cortisone and ACTH which modified the salt-retaining activity. Similar results may be possible with heart disease, Dr. Luetscher believes.

Science Grants Offered Students

ROCHESTER, N. Y. (AP)—Nineteen fellowships, each providing \$1,400 plus allowance for tuition and fees, will be awarded during the school year 1952-53 by the Eastman Kodak Co. and the Tennessee Eastman Co., a division of Kodak at Kingsport, Tenn.
Twelve of the fellowships are in chemistry, four in chemical engineering, and three in physics. They are offered to 18 U. S. educational institutions which will select a research student in the last year of study for his doctorate.
The basis of selection is the student's demonstrated ability in his major field of study, a high degree of technical promise, soundness of character and personal traits, and financial need.
Schools receiving the fellowships will be Northwestern University, Ohio State, Princeton, Illinois Institute of Technology, University of Rochester, Stanford University of Texas, Cornell, Harvard, University of Wisconsin, University of Tennessee, Emory, University of North Carolina, Virginia Polytechnic Institute, Georgia School of Technology, Catholic University of America, University of Illinois, and the Massachusetts Institute of Technology.
