

Amateur Sailors Reported Safe

OAKLAND, Calif., (UP)—Four amateur sailors returned safely to Easter Island aboard the "severely damaged" schooner Windjammer which has been drifting 2,000 miles off the west coast of Chile, it was reported yesterday. Peter Folini, Oakland "ham" radio operator said he received a telephone call from an army officer at Camp Kilmer, N.J., who in turn had received a call from an unidentified "ham" who intercepted a message from Peggy Poor, Folini had previously been in contact with Miss Poor, who was "marooned" on Easter Island since Aug. 11 when the Windjammer drifted out to sea after it put ashore to buy a new anchor.

The four crewmen, according to the message reported by Folini, survived the "dreadful experience with courage." However, Diego Pakarati, of Easter Island, was reported to have suffered a head injury. Miss Poor said that the vessel was "severely damaged" when it returned to port.
