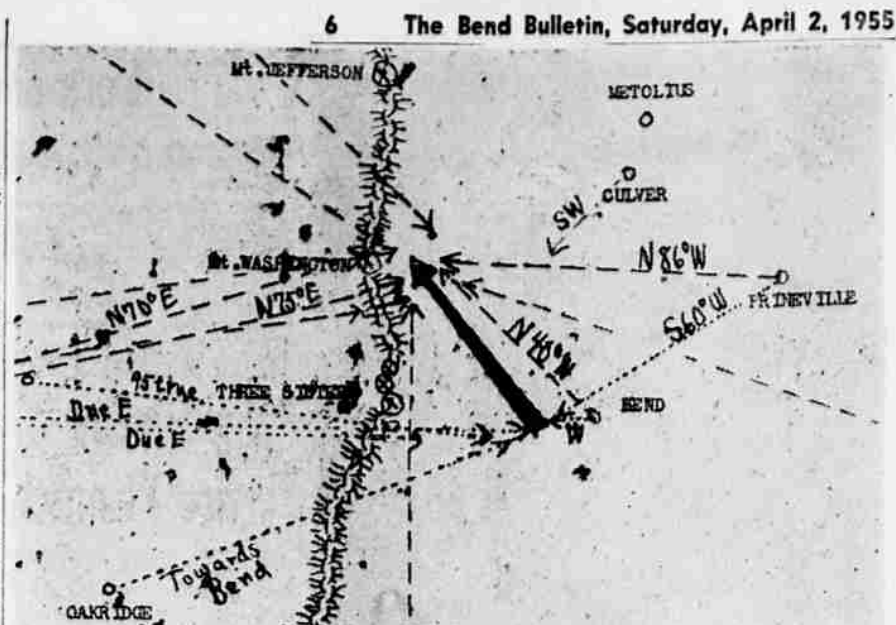

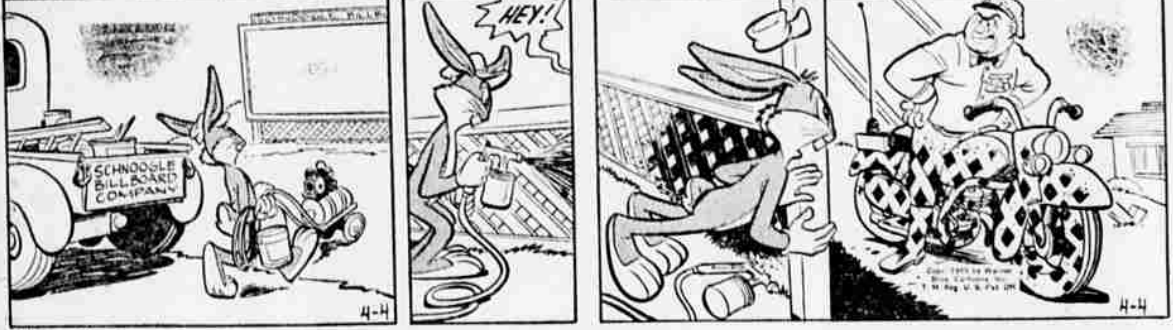

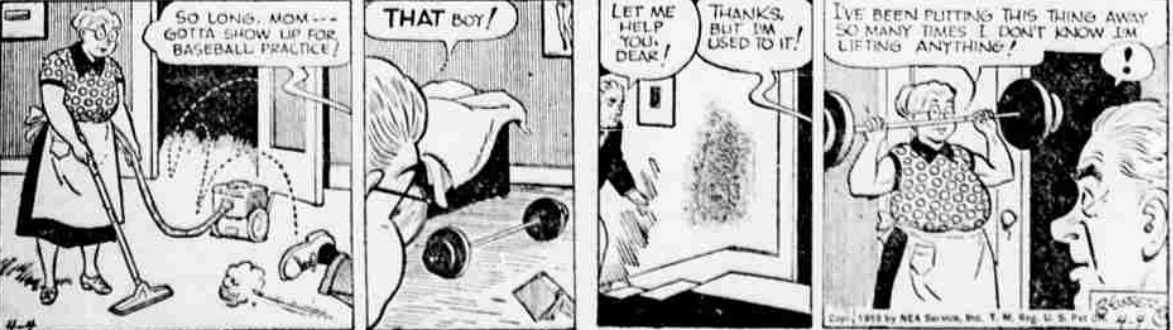

Course of Noisy, Brilliant Fireball on March 8 Traced

A noisy, brilliant fireball that cast shadows in Burns, lighted the Oregon coast and rattled ranch homes in Deschutes county as it plunged into the earth's atmosphere at about 7 p.m. on March 8 exploded about 20 miles above ground, just east of Mt. Washington.

fireball, traveling much faster than the speed of sound, was deceptive. A number of the observers were certain the object fell very close to them. A Grants Pass man thought the fireball hit the top of a hangar only a few blocks distant and called on a deputy sheriff to investigate.

Named the "Mad March meteor," the globe disintegrated after boring through the atmosphere at a terrific speed. The object became luminous some 65 miles above the earth and shed sparks and flames until it disintegrated at the 20 mile level.
