Blind Man Now Machinist

MONTPELIER, Vt. — (UP) — Raymond Koier of Randolph is a skilled machinist who operates lathes and other intricate machinery as well as his co-workers although he is blind. In working at his lathe, Koier uses a braille micrometer. This is a standard instrument with raised lines and dots which enables him to measure to a thousandth of an inch. Koier, who came to Vermont with his wife from New York City in 1945, was blinded shortly after arriving. After a business venture failed and he was laid off by a local manufacturer, he enrolled in the state vocational school, division of services for the blind. From the course Koier learned his present skills and shortly after completing the course was employed as a drill press operator.
