Ike Expected to Spell Out His 'Modern Republicanism'

 WASHINGTON (UP) — President Eisenhower's formal definition of his proposed modern Republicanism is about six weeks away. It will come in his annual message and budget message to the new Congress which convenes Jan. 3, 1957.

Modern Republicanism was the phrase Mr. Eisenhower used in his victory speech on election night to describe his own political position and the position to which he intends to move the foundations of the Republican Party. Or, perhaps, he feels the shift already has been made.

The election returns convinced Mr. Eisenhower that the Republican Party must achieve a new look. In his first news conference after the votes were counted, the President put it in his own words:

"Some change in the understanding that the public has of the Republican Party is necessary."

Not Aware Of New GOP

The President's language indicates that he feels modern Republicanism has been achieved but that the voters are not yet aware of it. He sees his political job during the next four years to be one of demonstrating to the voters that modern Republicanism has prevailed over the old-time GOP religion.

The details of modern Republicanism as to taxes and spending remain to be revealed in the two big January messages. There will be a preview of the 1957 model of the President's domestic program on Dec. 13 when he meets with the cabinet and GOP congressional leaders.

Mr. Eisenhower was asked at his first post-election news conference how he planned to win the GOP's support for his effort to modernize the party. The President replied that even though he should be convinced by now the public must get a new understanding of the Republican Party and what it stands for.

Margaret Has No Plan to Drop Her Career

NEW YORK (UP) — Margaret Truman, an old-fashioned girl fashioning a new future as a housewife, says she has no intention of dropping her career.

But now that she is Mrs. Clifton Daniel, wife of a newspaperman, the career always will run second to marriage.

Miss Truman, in her first interview since she became a bride last April 21, discussed her future as singer, wife, hostess, interior decorator, and cook.

She also took notice of all those gossip columnist reports she is expecting. "I came down with a virus for a couple of weeks," she laughingly commented, "and that really started the talk. Certainly we hope to have children. But those rumors I keep hearing... well, they're just rumors."

The blonde, 32-year-old daughter of former President Harry Truman said she will continue her musical career, and just might be lured into a stage role "if the right thing came along."

"I'm working on recordings now," she said. "These will be in the popular field." She still studies voice—three lessons a week—and has an NBC contract which runs until September 1957. It calls for special rather than regular appearances on television.

More Work

"I certainly plan to go on working," she said. "I'm no less ambitious now... but naturally marriage is more important."

Matter of fact, she said, she probably will be a better wife because "I once was strictly a career girl. I learned to budget my time... I hope this lesson carries over to my new life."

Then she admitted ruefully that she hadn't budgeted enough time to do her Christmas shopping. "And I have a list THAT long," she said.

Margaret Truman's day usually begins at eight in the morning—"Seems like the middle of the night," she said. "I used to sleep until 10 or 11."

"I guess learning to get up that early is the biggest adjustment I've had to make in marriage."

Navy Arms Ships With Sub Rocket

WASHINGTON (UP)—The Navy disclosed today that its hunter-killer ships are being armed with a powerful new anti-submarine rocket known as "weaponable."

The rocket, which carries a conventional explosive charge, may be the forerunner of a ship-launched atomic depth charge. It has been under secret development by the Navy for several years as one answer to the underwater threat posed by Russia's large submarine fleet.

A Navy spokesman said all five of the new 3,480-ton leader class destroyers are now equipped with the rocket. Most of the 20 escort destroyers in the active fleet are now armed with the weapon. All new destroyer escorts will have the weapon.

The Navy said the weapon will give destroyers "greater range and latitude of attack" against submarines. It gave no details on the rocket's range.
