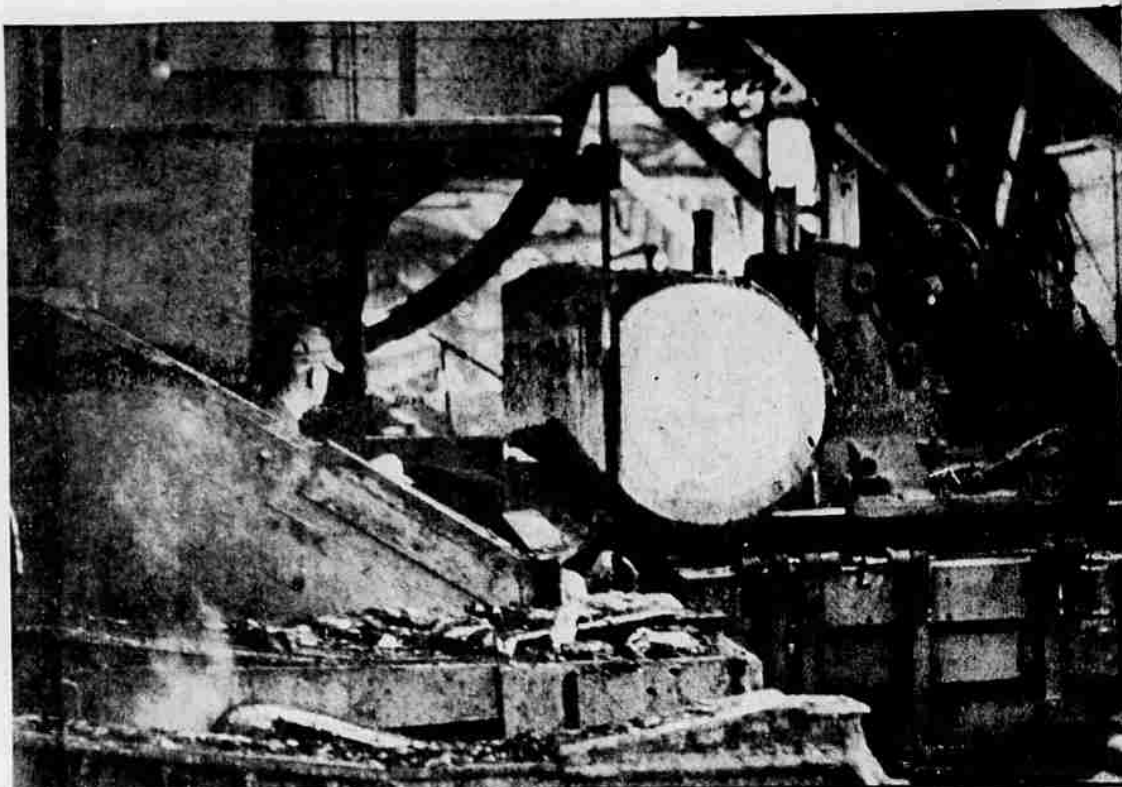




Harold Persons, Pond man, starts a big one up the bull chain into the mill.



The first bite of the head rig gives a flat surface to work from.



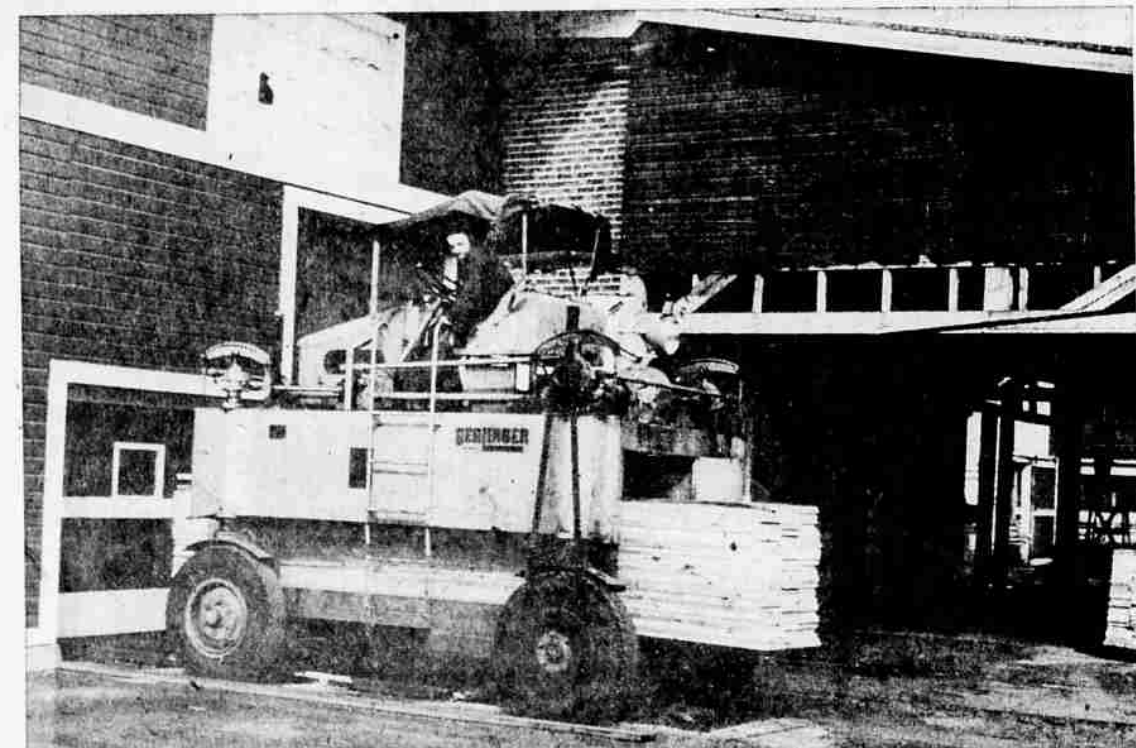
Over and over she goes and where she stops... Well, wait and see.



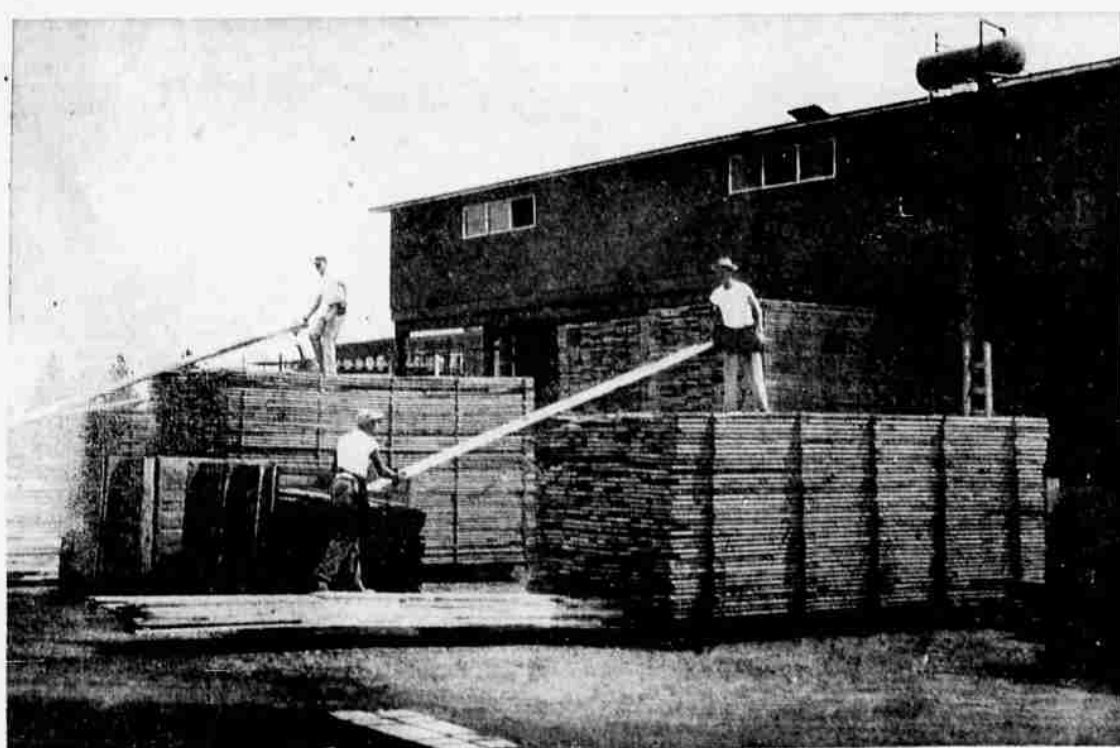
The last slab falls off... it will remain in this position to be sawn to the proper thickness.
