Labor Leaders

WASHINGTON (UPD - Labor lenders were heartened today by appointment of five liberal Democrats to the House Education and Labor Committee

AFL-CIO officials said the new members and the increased Demscratic margin over Republicans-20 to 10-had improved chances for labor-backed legislation.

The House committee often has been a burial ground for union-supported bills.

Labor sources said major AFL-CIO goals at this session of Congress were an anti-racketeering bill, certain Taft-Hartley Law revisions, and extension of coverage under the federal minimum wage

Meantime, Rep. Carroll D. Kearns (R-Pa.), top GOP mem-ber of the labor group, announced he will sponsor President Eisen hower's labor program in the House. He said it contained "no union-busting tactics" and should be acceptable to both Democrats and Republicans.

Kearns said the proposals would protect union rights, tighten laws on secondary boycotts, protect un ion treasuries against irresponsi ble officials and provide for "true and responsible collective bargain
