Eleven crops top billion dollar mark

WASHINGTON (UPI)—An Agriculture Department survey showed today there were 11 crops which brought cash receipts of more than one billion dollars each last year.

The survey also showed that 11 states collected more than one billion dollars each in gross farm income.

Five of the billion-dollar crops were either livestock or livestock products, five were individual field crops, and one was the total of all vegetables except potatoes.

The Department's publication, "The Farm Income Situation," showed cash receipts of \$20,500,000,000 for livestock and livestock products, and \$14,800,000,000 for field crops.

The leading money producers in the livestock and products category were: Cattle and calves, \$7,596,186,000; Dairy products, \$4,988,372,000; Hogs, \$3,774,485,000; Eggs \$1,934,885,000; and Broilers, \$1,002,186,000.

Field crops in the billion-dollar range were: Wheat, \$2,255,416,000; Cotton line and cottonseed, \$2,137,000; Corn, \$1,417,360,000; Soybeans, \$1,117,465,000; and Tobacco, \$1,007,443,000.

California, which has more diversified farming than any other state, led in gross income with \$2,829,463,000.

Second was Iowa, the great midwestern corn-hog state, with \$2,559,909,000. Texas was third with cash receipts of \$2,372,620,000.

The other billion-dollar states were: Indiana, \$1,089,552,000; Illinois, \$2,083,779,000; Wisconsin, \$1,117,675,000; Minnesota, \$1,467,752,000; Missouri, \$1,092,419,000; Nebraska, \$1,247,744,000; Kansas, \$1,163,696,000; and North Carolina, \$1,010,660,000.

Union, business leaders split on reform bill

WASHINGTON (UPI)—Union and business leaders split today over relative merits of the House Labor Committee's newly completed labor reform bill.

Another battle loomed on Wednesday, when the bitterly divided committee is scheduled to take a formal vote on its version of the Senate-approved Kennedy-Edwin bill.

The AFL-CIO and U.S. Chamber of Commerce withheld official comment on the House measure until they could examine it closely for possible hidden defects.

But union officials generally were agreeably surprised by the committee's action Friday and said the House bill would be far "easier to live with" than the Senate measure.

Business spokesmen and conservative congressmen, however, contended that the 100-plus amendments adopted by the 30-member House group pulled the teeth from the Senate's proposals.

AFL-CIO sources said the elimination of criminal penalties, jail terms and fines, for union officials violating the "bill of rights" provisions in the House measure made it more acceptable to labor.

Rep. Edgar W. Hiestand (R-Calif.) served notice he will make another effort Wednesday to get the House group to approve a tougher bill.
