Nixon praised by President

WASHINGTON (UPI) - President Eisenhower has sent Vice President Richard M. Nixon a personal message expressing his "admiration and respect" for the way Nixon conducted himself during his 10-day visit to Russia.

White House Press Secretary James C. Hagerty said the mess-age was waiting for Nixon when he returned to Moscow Friday from a visit into Siberia.

"The President," Hagerty said, "has sent a personal message to the vice president expressing his admiration and respect for the manner in which he has conducted himself throughout his tour of the Soviet Union."

Text of the message itself was not disclosed.

Hagerty's office said the message was substantially the same as that contained in the press secretary's announcement.

He had emphasized earlier that it was entirely personal in nature and contain ed no official structions to the vice president.


