ing for a total cost of \$862.52, in-
cluding material and labor.
**IN THE MATTER OF IM-
PROVEMENT OF
SKYLINER ROAD:**
The Court at this time ap-
proved plans to add an 09 oil mat to
the existing 09 oil mat now on
Skyliner's Road to permit the
opening of the Forest lands in
the Tumalo Creek area and the
hauling of logs over this road.
It was agreed that the County
and the National Forest Service

ed the Oregon Transportation, Inc.,
as carrier to transport Deschutes
County oil.
**IN THE MATTER OF DES-

At this time the Court appoint-
ed Ellis Edgington to the Deschutes
County Fair Board for a
two year term, ending April 1,
1962.
