In the one-hour "Golden Showcase" special on CBS-TV, the central marital relationship emerged with all the warmth of an Army cot.

Adapters Audrey Gellen and Jacqueline Babbitt turned Jan de Hartog's glowing study of the complexities of wedded bliss into a confused, confusing crazyquilt.

The comedy pace ran off with the subtleties and crushed into the floorboards whatever poignant universalities the play intended to honor.

Jackie Cooper and Tammy Grimes were unable to shape the characters of Michael and Agnes into full-bodied, believable people. It isn't entirely the fault of the script and Ronald Winston's direction, either.

While it was all too much, I thought Fielder Cook's handling of the cast—it included Lee Remick, Peter Lawford, Charles Bickford and Cornelia Otis Skinner—made for professionally effective light-weight entertainment.

"John Brown's Body," a full-hour dramatized reading on CBS-TV, was made of sturdy stuff and radiated honest passion and compassion.
